# • <u>Citadel Completions LLC (Contracts #20180199-ITE, #20180199-A-ITE, and #20180199-B-ITE):</u>

Citadel Completions LLC is requesting to amend their existing Exhibit A agreement for Contract #20180199-ITE to:

- Add 2 additional years to the project (Phase Contracts #20180199-A-ITE and #20180199-B-ITE)
   which were not accounted for when filing the "front-end" Application in 2018.
- Lower the required number of jobs/payroll initially agreed upon
- Add the maximum allowable renewal term (3-yrs. at 80% exemption)

<u>From the Company:</u> "Citadel Completions LLC ("Citadel") is making a special request regarding the above referenced Project. Citadel is requesting to include two additional years to the Project in order to cover the A and B Contract phases (20180199-A-ITE & 20180199-B-ITE) which were not accounted for during this front end filing.

Additionally, we are requesting that the Exhibit A for this Contract and its phases be amended to reflect that the Project will create a total of 130 new direct jobs with \$10 million in annual payroll for the remaining applicable years of the Project. The original jobs anticipated included contract labor and workers and those not deemed domiciled in Louisiana. Based on the understanding of Louisiana Economic Development's definition of a new direct job we are confident in our ability to create and maintain 130 new direct jobs with the stated payroll. We have attached Resolutions and/or Letter from the applicable Calcasieu Parish governing bodies that support this amendment and the below requested renewal.

Lastly, we would like to request that the appropriate renewal terms be added to the amended Exhibit A. When the original Contract was created we were approved for the initial five-year term (100% exemption) with the anticipation of recommending a renewal Contract of 3 years (80% exemption)."

We sincerely appreciate your time and consideration."

#### • Flopam, Inc. (Contract #20180148-ITE):

Flopam, Inc. is requesting to amend their existing Exhibit A agreement for Contract #20180148-ITE to extend the Commencement of Operations date from December 31, 2022 to December 31, 2024, and add two additional years to the project in order to account for additional years of assets coming into service (e.g. Phase Contracts).

#### From the Company:

"We originally planned for our expansion project to wrap up by the end of last year, December 2022, but we encountered several unanticipated challenges during the project resulting from supply chain delays, labor shortages, and market downturns that prevented us from reaching this initial goal. Our current expectation is that this project should conclude late this year (December 2023), but given our recent challenges, it is possible the project extends into 2024.

At the conclusion of our project, we will have spent over \$300M, created over 100 new jobs, and expanded our annual payroll by millions of dollars. We are on track to satisfy our investment amount, new job, and new payroll ITEP compliance requirements, it is timing that is causing us challenges. In an abundance of caution, we hereby request permission to update our planned Commencement of Operations date to better reflect our current expected timeline. Thanks in advance for your time and consideration."

#### • Cornerstone Chemical Company (Contract #20170416-ITE):

Cornerstone Chemical Company is requesting to amend their existing Exhibit A agreement for Contract #20170416-ITE to reflect a commitment to retain 350 jobs and \$33,000,000 in annual payroll at the manufacturing site.

In addition, while the formal submission of the 2022 Project Year compliance reporting is not due until later in 2023, because Cornerstone anticipates that the 2022 Project Year will be non-compliant for the same reasons as 2020 and 2021, the Company requests that the 2022 Project Year non-compliance be considered at this Board Meeting.

From the Company: "Cornerstone Chemical Company is writing this letter to make a special request to amend its Exhibit A to include the guidance provided by the local governing authorities in Jefferson Parish. In previous correspondence, LED notified the local governing authorities that Cornerstone Chemical Company was non-compliant according to the existing Exhibit A in the 2021 Project Year. This correspondence gave the local governing authorities until Jan. 21, 2023 to opine regarding this non-compliance. It is Cornerstone Chemical Company and the local governing authorities' preference that the Exhibit A be amended to reflect a commitment to retain 410 jobs and \$39,000,000 in annual payroll within Jefferson Parish for Project Years 2023 and forward. After further discussions with LED, Cornerstone provided a manufacturing site only anticipated jobs of 350 and \$33,000,000 in payroll at the request of LED to separate the 410 jobs and \$39,000,000 in payroll between the manufacturing site and the company headquarters, both of which are in Jefferson Parish."
